### Abstract

In this edition we are pleased to launch a new section, "Clinical Review", in which we will present solicited articles written by experts in the field. These will particularly aim to cover controversial topics and areas of rapid advance. In the current edition, we are excited to publish a review of the recent advances in TB diagnostics: Dr Beate Kampmann's thoughtful article provides an excellent update on the role of new cytokine-based diagnostic tools, and highlights the continuing difficulty in distinguishing TB infection and disease, particularly in children with HIV.

We will also publish "Clinical Guideline Updates" which will cover hot topics in modern paediatrics from a practical viewpoint, in a user-friendly format. We hope you enjoy the new edition.
